



Small Volume PCB-Containing Lighting Ballasts
Generator Declaration Form

Some lighting ballasts manufactured prior to July 1, 1980 contain polychlorinated biphenyls (PCBs) and require special handling. The LightRecycle program provides a courier-based recycling service to generators with small volumes of PCB-containing lighting ballasts generated in British Columbia without charge.

To qualify for this service, generators must complete the following declaration form. Once completed, the form must be brought to the courier location for drop off with the PCB-containing lighting ballasts.

The Generator acknowledges and agrees and certifies that for this shipment:

- a. PCB-containing lighting ballasts are properly identified and segregated from other products and no other products, such as lighting ballasts that do not contain PCBs, are placed in the shipping container for PCB-containing lighting ballasts.
- b. The PCB-containing lighting ballasts are packaged in a properly labelled, LightRecycle approved shipping container in accordance with any guidelines or instructions provided by LightRecycle to the Generator.
- c. The PCB ballasts were generated within British Columbia.
- d. **LESS than five kilograms** of PCB-containing lighting ballasts are contained in the shipping container (typically a maximum of two ballasts), in accordance with the requirements of the BC Hazardous Waste Regulations (BCHWR).
